PFC Code of Conduct – 2017/03/14

Membership in the Penticton Flying Club – COPA Flight 50 (PFC) is a privilege, shared equally by each and every member. The PFC cultural environment is defined and safeguarded by the following principles, agreed to by everyone granted membership, to ensure an enjoyable, friendly and safe environment.

1. Members are obligated to comply with and support the constitution, bylaws and operating rules of the PFC while exercising their rights, privileges and responsibilities granted by PFC membership. In so doing, members will exercise their rights without personal financial gain.
2. Members are expected to treat others with courtesy, respect, dignity and civility, showing consideration for the well-being of their body, emotions, privacy and property without intimidation, discrimination or prejudice. Harassment, sexual or otherwise, shall not be tolerated, nor shall threats of violence, acts of violence or damage to/disrespect for personal or public property.
3. Members must not be abusive or use obscene, offensive or foul language in general conversation and/or specifically toward PFC members or the public.
4. Members must not engage in illegal activity while on PFC facilities, or utilizing PFC property, including Club Aircraft or while representing PFC or identifying as PFC members in any manner.
5. Members shall not represent the Society in any dealings or enterprises without prior permission of the PFC Executive and shall not misrepresent their position or authority to others.
6. Members shall not tarnish the character, integrity and/or reputation of the PFC, its Officers, Directors and/or committees; nor give cause for PFC to be involved in legal action.
7. Members are responsible for the actions and behaviour of their guests, adults or children and-or pets, while on PFC property or airside.
8. Members are not to disclose to any unauthorized entity, information that might be confidential or privileged, nor promote or disseminate information that is offensive, scandalous, unsubstantiated or derisive with respect to the PFC and/or its members.
9. Where an “honour” payment system is utilized, members shall comply.

Any breach of the above principles is to be reported to the Executive who shall evaluate the alleged breach and shall, if required, carry out disciplinary actions in accordance with the Constitution, Bylaws, and operating rules of the PFC.

If a Society member is in arrears with membership dues for more than 90 days, that member shall be deemed as resigned and will forfeit all privileges and entitlements that membership affords until they reapply and are accepted as members.
